They are coming out with a larger size, so if your lens is too big a diameter for the fitting, then you could wait.

Since 2005, Bob has held the positions of President, Competition Coordinator, Training Coordinator and was elected a Life Member in 2010. He is currently the support officer for the club web site.

He has conducted 70 weekend studio portrait workshops for club members since 2007.

With his wife, he enjoys travel on photography tours and runs his own home-based studio.

Bob has been the recipient of many awards within his club, up to and including Image of the Year.

Bob commenced judging in 2013 and is a qualified judge with the Federation of Camera Clubs.

The Graham Burstow Street Photography Mono Prize was established in 2023

Graham Burstow OAM SAPS PSQA FFRPS FAPS EFIAP

who was one of the founding members of the Australian Photographic Society and since that time, he contributed enormously to the Society and its members. He was involved in the establishment of APSs national and international exhibitions. Graham was the APS President from 1982 to 1984 and was the APS Print Division chairman for ten years.

Graham passed away at the age of 96 years in 2022, and was legendary in the photography world, having been recognised by an Order of Australia medal in 2004 for his services to Photography. The first Queenslander to do so, he achieved a Fellowship in each of the Australian, British, and American Photographic Societies.
